1. OPERATIONAL ACHIEVEMENTS

This quarter the total number of beneficiaries who were provided services is 313.

Everyday beneficiaries: 150 (72 children and 53 elderly, 25 needy adults)

Additional beneficiaries: 163 (22-cooked food, 34-dry food, 58-clothes and school supplies, 13- families-money donation, 5- students payment for study; 10- other services).

Orran send clothes for 14 villages in Karabagh, “Zangak” orphanage in Stepanakert, as well as 6 military units in Karabagh.

1. Children- Newcomers- 6 children are now coming to Orran on daily basis

- Child 1 (Boy 6 years old, homeless unemployed parents with 5 children)
- Child 2 (Girl of 9 years old, homeless lonely father with 3 children)
- Child 3 (Girl of 7 years old, homeless lonely father with 3 children)
- Child 4 (Boy of 12 years old, homeless lonely father with 3 children)
- Child 5 (Girl of 16 years old, lonely mother with 2 children)
- Child 6 (Girl of 16 years old, lonely mother with the daughter)

- Elderly 3- 74 years old pensioner, who has 2 daughters with the psychological disease
- Elderly 4- 87 years old pensioner, homeless and lonely

- Elderly 1 - 82 years old (she is now a beneficiary of Mission East program)

- Elderly 4 – 75 years old (she is now a beneficiary of Mission East program)
- Elderly 5 - 80 years old, unfortunately passed away

1.0. Food Program

This quarter the number of beneficiaries who received food service is **206**:

- 72** children received food on everyday basis;
- 53** elderly received food on everyday basis;
- 25** additional beneficiaries received food on everyday basis;
- 22** additional beneficiaries received cooked food;
- 34** people (extremely needy families) were helped by dry food packages.

1.2. Clothes, Shoes (school supply, bags) Program

This quarter the number of beneficiaries, who received clothes and shoes are **2688 (697-to Orran beneficiaries and 1991 to people from out)** and **1363** item school supplies are distribute (774 for Orran children and 589 children from out).

- In 3rd quarter 9 boxes of clothes were distribute to “Zartong Ayutyan” NGO for frontier villages’ resettlement and development.

1.3. Social Work (utilities, flat rental)

- Orran covers the flat rental fee for Kankanyan’s family (**7** member) (total 3rd quarter **101 560 AMD**) by Klara Mooradkhan’s target donation;
- Orran covers the flat rental fee for lonely father Avetik Khachatryan’s family (4 members) (total 3rd quarter **30.000 AMD**), **41 000 AMD** for bedding materials and **3 500 AMD** for school books by Talin Amirian’s target donation;
- Orran gives **70.000 AMD (15.000 AMD from AmCham program)** the flat rental fee to Anush Arakelyan’s homeless family;
- Orran gives **6 000 AMD** to Orran child Andranik Malkhasyan’s family for school examinations and **4 500 AMD** for school books;
- Orran covers **20.000 AMD** the flat rental fee (July, August) for homeless elderly Mary Hayrapetyan;
- Orran gives **10.000 AMD** for food to Gayane Papazyan by **AmCham** program;
- Orran gives **10.000 AMD** for food to Murad Karapetyan by **AmCham** program;
- Orran covers the flat rental fee for Krikurova Yelena’s homeless family (**3** member) (**15.000 AMD**);
- Orran gives **120 330 AMD** to Vartan Kirakosyan by **AmCham** program for electrical equipment and food;
- Orran gives **10.000 AMD** for food to Anahit Mamikonyan’s needy family;
- Orran gives **2 800 AMD** to Narine Sargsyan’s family for school’s books;
- Orran gives **180 000 AMD** to Adibekyan Siranush by Madeline Minasian’s target donation;
- Orran gives **5 000 AMD** to Krikurova Ruzanna for electricity.

1.4. Transportation

This quarter 58 children received money for transportation to be able to attend Orran.

Social work details are presented in Exhibit “1”.

1.5. Volunteers

This quarter we had **18** active volunteers involved in the overall activities of Orran:

- 6 - Academic service
- 8 - Psychological therapy
- 2 - Religion
- 1 - Cultural service
- 1 - Web site developer, web administrator

This quarter Orran volunteers working hours are **864** (18 x 48 hours).

2. ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENTS

Orran teachers Marianna Harutyunyan, Astghik Hovhannisyan and Sayat Babayan continued to work on summer and educational programs in Orran.

The following activities have been implemented:

- Reading and discussing fairy tales, stories;
- Organizing of out door games in the garden;
- Watching films, cartoons and discussions;
- Reading poems of well-known Armenian writers;
- Writing Compositions and Exercises;
- Organizing Intellectual and word games;
- Meeting with parents of Orran children;
- 2 home visits and meetings with parents (Arpine Najaryan, Gevorg Shahumyan);
- Meeting with 16 parents of Orran children;
- Organizing English, Russian and Armenia classes in senior and middle groups;
- Work around study program of children;
- Organizing Religion classes every Thursday by volunteers from Gevorkyan Theological Seminary of Etchmiadzin;
- Organizing group work by volunteers with Orran children.

2.1 Education, Further Adult Education/Training

Handcraft teacher Geghanush Tovmasyan continues to teach macramé to 23 and gobelin to 9 children. Mrs. Tovmasyan's pupils prepared 90 wonderful works for Month of Orran sale-exhibition and also 200 little gifts for the donors.

Wood engraving teacher Mr. Marzpet Kirakosyan continues wood engraving lessons for 30 Orran children. Day by day the interest in Orran handicraft projects has increased.

- Terteryan Armine studies at the Management University, Foreign Languages Department targeted donation of Ohan Varjabedian;
- Nune Ashughyan studies at Romanos Melikyans Musical College, annual fee 200 000 AMD, targeted donation of Ohan Varjabedian;
- Gasparyan Ruzanna studies at Management College of Foreign Economical Affairs, targeted donation of Ohan Varjabedian;
- Mariam Sirunyan graduated "Vaga" Center as a florist;
- Gevorgyan Seda graduated "Vaga" Center as a florist.

3. PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES

This quarter 72 children and 33 parents received psychological services.

Psychologist Narine Avagyan uses art therapy, story and music therapy for individuals, open and closed groups.

Individual work was organized with 47 children, Art therapy – with 72 children.

4. MEDICAL SERVICES

This quarter pediatrician Irina Rafayelyan examined 72 children.

- Individual explanatory work about hygiene with all groups of children;
- Organizing “Mantou” test in T.B. prophylactic centre for 6 children;
- Preparing Menu for the meals of children and elderly;
- Meeting with parents;
- Visiting “Arabkir” medical centre for Orran child Andranik Malkhasyan;

5. DENTAL SERVICES

- Dentist Zhanna Safaryan and dental nurse Anahit Khachatryan continues dental examination of Orran children;
- This quarter the number of beneficiaries who received dental service is 50.
- From August 13 – up to September 10 – dentist and her nurse had vacation.

6. CULTURAL AND RECREATIONAL SERVICES

- 16 Orran children were invited Yerevan Puppet show performance “Golden Fish” by HSBC bank September 9th;
- Trip to Mrgashen village in Kotayk Marz with Orran little group children, September 28th
- 25 children of Orran were invited to National Museum by HSBC bank September 29th.
